

Granny Square



This motif is made in 4 colors but is also attractive in a combination of 2 or 3 colors. With color A ch 4 join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Still using color A, ch 2, 2 dc into centre of ring, *ch 2, 3 dc into centre ring *, repeat from * to * twice more, ch 2, join with a sl st to top of original ch 2. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join color B yarn in a corner ch 2 space, ch 2, 2 dc into same space, ch 2, 3 dc into same space, * ch 2, 3 dc into next corner space, ch 2, 3 dc into same space *, repeat from * to * twice more, ch 2, join with a sl st to top of original ch 2. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join color C yarn in corner space, ch 2, 2 dc into same space, ch 2, 3 dc into same space, *ch 2, 3 dc into next ch 2 space, ch 2, 3 dc into next corner space, ch 2, 3dc into same space *, repeat from * to * around, ch 2, join with sl st to top of original ch 2. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join color D in a corner and repeat previous rnd, (with the exception that you have 2 spaces to fill in with 3 dc) between each corner. Join as before. Fasten off.

Sew in ends neatly on wrong side. Press lightly with a damp cloth and warm iron.

Knitted Square

- 25 sts.
- Size 5mm needles
- 6" length (15 ½ cm)

Crochet Granny Square

- Size 6 mm
- 5 Patters
- 6" x 6" (15 ½ cm x 15 ½ cm)
